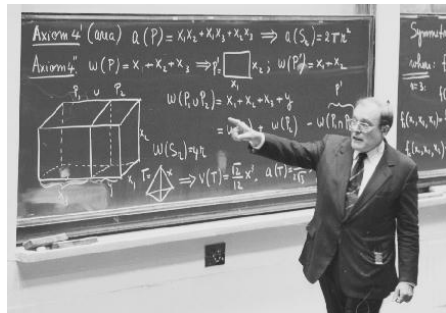
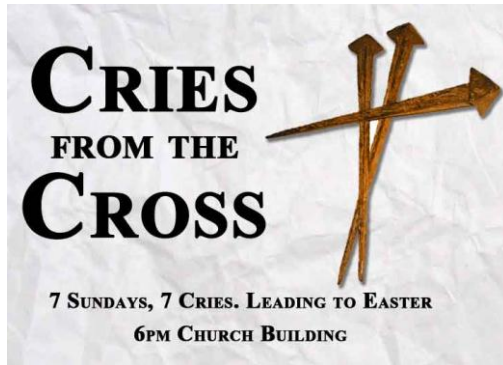
February 12th
